

## 2025-2026 GATE Parent Referral

## Dear Parent,

We are currently accepting referrals for students who may be eligible for Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) for the 2025-2026 school year.

The purpose of GATE is to enable identified students to reach their intellectual potential by providing them with opportunities and experiences that will challenge and further develop their thinking, reasoning, and problem-solving skills (both in and out of the classroom).

There is a significant difference between the "bright" child and the "gifted" child. Please see the table below for these significant differences and characteristics that may help you ascertain whether or not your student might meet the characteristics to be tested.


